# Eclectic Motorworks

## Tuning For Speed

*\*\* This seminar focuses on tuning techniques to get the most out of your British car \*\**

**Saturday** Seminar begins promptly at 9:00am at Eclectic Motorworks in Holland, Michigan. We will start with a complete description of a comprehensive tune up: Engine condition, ignition, carburetion, and emissions. We will tune one participant's car as participants work with us to view the methods and techniques of proper tuning. After lunch we will begin discussing performance recipes. We will end the shop day between 5 and 6pm. After allowing some clean-up time, we will gather at The Piper restaurant for a meal and more discussion.

**Sunday** Seminar begins promptly at 9:00am. We will continue discussions of performance recipes that include ignition, fuel systems, forced induction (supercharging), brakes, chassis, driveline, and safety upgrades. During this discussion, participants will be able to hold and inspect Eclectic Motorworks' vast inventory of speed parts—nearly every speed part available for the MGA/MGB (heads, cams, carbs, ignitions, superchargers, suspension, and more). MGBs will be on display featuring supercharging, crossflow heads, V8 conversion, EFI/DOHC Miata 4 conversion, and more! We'll look at copies of the dyno data taken from the dyno sessions. We will also talk about modern and vintage performance accessories.

**Dyno** An optional Monday-morning dyno session is available at Baker Engineering in Nunica if class participants would like to bring their cars. Each car will make several baseline pulls and some minor tuning MAY be able to be completed during your time. Dyno time is \$95 per car, with a minimum of 2 cars necessary in order to schedule dyno time. We will meet at the shop at 9:00am and drive to Nunica, approximately 45 minutes north of Holland. Maps will be provided should they be necessary.

NOTE: This is an elevated chassis dyno and narrow cars (MG Midget, Austin/Morris Mini etc.) will not fit due to the setup of the lift.

**HOURS** Saturday 9:00 am -> Late  
Sunday 9:00 am -> approximately 5:00 pm

**COSTS** Registration is \$495 for the two days.

## **HOTELS**

There are many good, inexpensive hotels in the Holland area. Holland is divided into 2 distinct areas, referred to as the North side and South side (divided by the Black River). Hotels on the South (nearest to Eclectic Motorworks) include the 2 downtown hotels (The Haworth Inn and the CityFlats Hotel) and several other hotels along the US 31 corridor. On the north side there are many hotels along the US 31 corridor near Westshore Mall and several other retail complexes. Please note that hotels with a 49424 zip code are on the North side, 49423 on the South.

For those attending with spouses or other family members in tow we highly recommend the 2 downtown hotels. Historic Downtown Holland is beautiful any time of year with plenty of shopping, dining and entertainment options. For those seeking less-expensive accommodations the hotels along US 31 offer a variety of options.

We will be providing you with coffee and snacks, lunch on both days and dinner on Saturday night. You will be responsible for any additional meals.

## **FLYING**

Gerald R. Ford International Airport in Grand Rapids is the closest major airport to Eclectic Motorworks (approximately 45 minutes away). Rental cars are available on-site from most major companies.
